## Request for video proposals to honour great Canadian artists

The Canada Council for the Arts and the Independent Media Arts Alliance (IMAA) are once again coming together to honour the recipients of the [Governor General's Awards in Visual and Media Arts](#) (GGAVMA).

We are looking to pair Canadian directors with the 2019 GGAVMA winners to create artistic video portraits (3 minutes max., including credits/bumpers). We also encourage production centres and directors to enter an agreement that would help cover the costs of services and equipment they might need.

The commissioned directors will be acknowledged in every way possible as creators of these videos. The video portraits will be shown on Council's web site and YouTube channel. They will be promoted via social media, on partners' web sites and at public events organized by the National Gallery of Canada and the Office of the Secretary to the Governor General of Canada. The commissioned directors and IMAA members are also encouraged to show the works on their websites and social media channels.

The videos will be a key element of a national campaign to raise the profile of the winners and the visual arts, media arts and fine craft in Canada.

Each video will be an artistic and original portrait of the GGAVMA winner of which the commissioned director has complete creative control. Ideally, it will celebrate the winner's achievement and the impact his or her life's work has made on the lives of Canadians.

The Council reserves the right to use the video portraits for promotional purposes. The commissioned directors retain copyright and ownership of their works, and may use them as they wish to promote their own work.

### Background

Created in 1999 by the Canada Council for the Arts and the Governor General of Canada, these prizes are awarded annually for distinguished career achievement in:

- independent film and video, audio and/or new media
- fine arts (painting, drawing, photography, print-making and sculpture – including installation and other three-dimensional work) and/or architecture
- Outstanding contributions to the visual and / or media arts in a volunteer or professional capacity
- fine crafts (Saidye Bronfman Award)

### Confidentiality

All data and information about this project shall be kept strictly confidential and shall not be disclosed to any third party without the express written consent of the Council.

### **Evaluation of the proposals**

All proposals will be rated on a “points earned” matrix that will involve an analysis of the complete proposal including, but not limited to:

1. Artistic approach
2. The ability of each director to carry out the project
3. The director suitability to the project
4. Support material
5. Budget and timeline

The Canada Council will strike an internal committee to assess the proposals. The Council retains complete discretion in deciding which proposals meet the requirements for this project and what evidence will be considered adequate to indicate compliance with these requirements. Note that geographical factors may be taken into consideration when pairing directors with artists. In addition, the Council reserves the right in its sole discretion to:

- Withdraw the call for proposals at any time
- Not enter into negotiations with any director that submits a proposal
- Request clarification of additional information regarding a proposal

Commissioned directors may not make any additional applications to Canada Council programs for funding related to this project.
